(d) On July 5, 2011 the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Douglas Dynamics, Inc. (the "Company") appointed Kenneth W. Krueger as a Class II independent director of the Company with an initial term expiring at the 2012 annual meeting of stockholders. Mr. Krueger has served as a director and Chairman of the Audit Committee of The Manitowoc Company, a multi-industry capital goods manufacturer headquartered in Manitowoc, Wisconsin, since 2004. From May 2006 until August 2009, Mr. Krueger was the Chief Operating Officer of Bucyrus International, Inc., a global mining equipment manufacturer headquartered in South Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Mr. Krueger was Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer of A. O. Smith Corporation, a global manufacturer of water heaters in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, from August 2000 until June 2005.

The Board appointed Mr. Krueger to the Compensation, Audit and Nominating and Governance Committees of the Board.

As a non-employee director, Mr. Krueger will receive the compensation paid to all non-employee directors of the Company as described in the Company's 2011 Proxy Statement on Schedule 14A filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission on March 30, 2011.

There are no arrangements between Mr. Krueger and any other person pursuant to which Mr. Krueger was elected to serve as a director, nor are there any transactions in which the Company is a participant in which Mr. Krueger has a material interest.
